RULES & REGULATIONS

General Guidelines

- The Super Kids competition is open to children (boys and girls) of members of AKCAF Association member colleges.
- Participants must register online at www.akcaf.org
- All participants will be allotted chest numbers one hour before the event begins at the venue.
- There will be four categories as below:
 - 3 to 5 years – Tiny Tots
 - 6 to 8 years – Little Stars
 - 9 to 12 years – Junior Trendsetters
 - 13 to 16 years – Young Icons
- Age eligibility will be calculated as of 4th October 2026.
- All participants should submit a copy of their Emirates ID to the Super Kids Committee for validation of their age and cross-verification at the Registration desk. Any manipulation of the same will result in disqualification.
- The competition consists of a ramp walk to showcase your outfit and personality. Kindly note that all Children must walk the ramp independently. Parents or guardians are not permitted to accompany them on stage. If needed, our backstage team shall assist and guide the children.



- Costumes should be age-appropriate and culturally respectful and follow our program theme – KERALA FUSION DRESSING.
- No property is allowed on the stage.
- Participants must report to the registration desk 1 hour before their competition to collect the chest number and be available backstage 30 minutes prior to the start of the competition after completing any final touch-up.
- Please come dressed in respective costumes and makeup. Dressing areas will be provided for 15 minutes only for final touch-up with your own makeup kit and may be shared with other contestants. Please be courteous and always display good sportsmanship.
- Only the winners will perform on the main programme day; hence, they must compulsorily attend the grooming sessions at the AKCAF Association Office for the same.
- If any contestant tries to influence the judge(s), she will be disqualified by the committee.
- All backdrops, properties, Costumes and LED visuals etc. must remain strictly cultural, inclusive, and secular. Should not feature religious deities, faith-based iconography, political emblems, or sub-community/caste identifiers. Strict compliance with UAE Media Council and Dubai CDA regulations is required.
